Musical director

Besides his role as Director of Music and Master of the Choir School at Bury Parish Church, **Marc Murray** is also Director of Music of Southport Bach Choir and Chester St. Cecilia Singers. In September, he completed a further MA in Performance Practice at the University of York, specializing in the performance of early organ and harpsichord repertoire under the supervision of Prof. Peter Seymour. Marc plans to remain at the York to complete his PhD.

He also holds teaching and performing qualifications from the University of South Africa; Trinity College of Music, London and the Royal College of Organists (both the Associate Diploma and Choral Directing Diploma of the College).

Born and educated in Cape Town, South Africa, he first read music at the University of Cape Town. He moved to the United Kingdom in May 2010 to take up the post of Director of Music at Boston Stump in Lincolnshire.

In South Africa, Marc worked for the National Department of Education on a music programme encouraging choral and solo singing. Here, he was also accompanist and vocal coach to the DoE's South African Youth Choir. He also worked as Acting Chorus Master and Assistant Chorus Master for Cape Town Opera.

Marc is currently President of the Manchester Organists' Association.
